Start with a non-stop flight into Queenstown, Dunedin, Christchurch or Invercargill

Drive Times & Distances from South Island's main airports

- **Queenstown to Cromwell**
54kms (33.5 miles) 48mins
- **Dunedin to Cromwell**
198kms (123 miles) 2hrs 40mins
- **Invercargill to Cromwell**
233kms (145 miles) 3 hours
- **Christchurch to Cromwell**
419kms (260 miles) 5hrs 15mins
